My Family and Me Preschool Lesson Plan | Learn About Family

Age Group:

3-5 years

Duration:

1 Class Period (30-45 minutes)

Theme/Topic:

Understanding and Appreciating Our Families

Learning Objectives:

By the end of this lesson, preschoolers ought to be able to:

- Identify and name members of their family.
- Describe the roles of different members of a family.
- Appreciate the uniqueness of their own family.
- Demonstrate love and appreciation for their family.

Developmental Areas Covered:

- 1. Language
- 2. Social & Emotional
- 3. Cognitive
- 4. Fine hidden Skills

Materials Needed:

- Family photo (brought from home)
- Chart paper or whiteboard
- Crayons, markers, glue sticks
- Printable family tree template
- Storybook (e.g., The Family Book by Todd Parr)

Lesson Procedure:

1. Welcome Circle (5 minutes)

- Sing a hello song.
- Introduce the theme: "Today we are going to talk about something very special—our families!"

2. Story Time (10 minutes)

- Read The Family Book by Todd Parr or a different family-themed book.
- Ask open-ended questions:
 - "Who's in your family?"
 - "What do you like to do with your family?"

3. Discussion and Sharing (5-10 minutes)

- Invite children to share their family pictures.
- Ask them to name every individual and say something they love about that individual.

4. Activity: Create a Family Tree (10–15 minutes)

- Distribute family tree templates.
- Assist kids in drawing or glueing family members' pictures.
- Allow them to colour and decorate the tree.

5. Music and Movement (5 minutes)

- Sing "Finger Family" or "We Are a Family."
- Promote basic movements and gestures during singing.

Assessment:

Observe if children can:

- Name the family members.
- Participate in sharing and listening.
- Complete the family tree with guidance.
